**Location:** Thomas F. Eagleton U.S. Courthouse  
**(NOTE:** Unlike in previous years, this program will be held entirely at a single location)

**Times:** Arrive at 8:30 a.m. for check-in. Program begins at 9:00 a.m. Dismissal will be at 4:30 p.m.



Learn what it means to be a citizen of the United States by participating in a full day of sessions held at the Thomas F. Eagleton U.S. Courthouse. A variety of presenters will cover the Badge requirements, including a federal judge. The workshop is free, but reservations are required, and space is limited.

**PLEASE READ CAREFULLY AS REGISTRATION HAS CHANGED FROM PREVIOUS YEARS:**

- Minimum age requirement: Scouts MUST have reached 13<sup>th</sup> birthday by July 21.
- Registrations will be taken on a first come, first served basis, **beginning at 7:00 A.M. on Monday, April 6**. Once the program is full, additional names will be added to a waiting list.
- To register, email [EducationTeam@ca8.uscourts.gov](mailto:EducationTeam@ca8.uscourts.gov) on Monday, April 6. Emails will be checked in the order they are received, beginning at 7:00 a.m. **Phone registrations will not be taken.**
  - Subject line of the email: *July 21 Citizenship in the Nation STL*
  - You may register multiple Scouts with one email, but you MUST have complete information for each Scout. Spots will not be held for any Scouts with missing information.
  - Include the following information for EACH Scout:
    - Full Name
    - Troop
    - Age Scout will be on July 21
    - Allergies/special needs/other health concerns
    - Name of parent attending (optional)
    - Name and cell # of an emergency contact who is NOT attending the program
    - Email address and phone number for each Scout/family

  - Each family is responsible for accessing the packet and going over the logistics on their own.
  - Each Scout must print out the pre-requisites, or complete on separate paper USING THE FORMAT IN THE PACKET. Do not use other packets you might find on other websites.

To Bring: Scouts should bring a copy of the Merit Badge Pamphlet, a pencil, and a signed Merit Badge Card. Scouts will need to bring completed pre-requisite activities, a lunch, a water bottle, and a morning snack.
