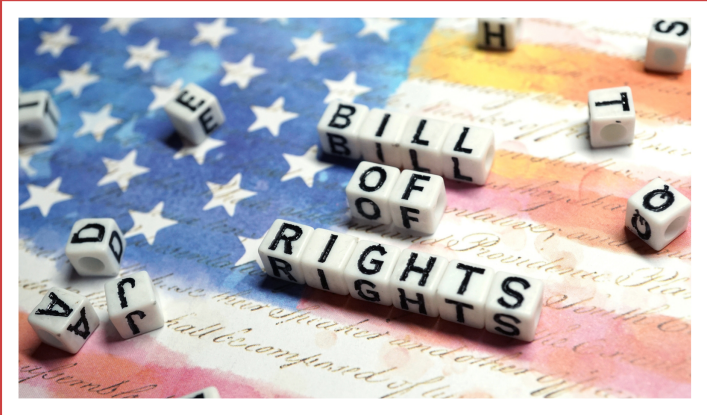

WHAT ENTRIES ARE ACCEPTED?

Winners will be awarded in each age category!

Drawings and paintings must include a 50-75-word (middle) or 200-word (high school) artist's statement that explains how the submission addresses the contest prompts.

Essays: 250-500 words (middle) & 500-800 words (high school)
