group will walk to the Eagleton Courthouse at 10:30
a.m., and be dismissed from there at 4:30 pm.



Learn what it means to be a citizen of the United States by participating in a variety of sessions, touring a site that is on the National Register of Historic Places, and touring a federal facility. The program begins at the Historic Old Courthouse and ends at the Thomas F. Eagleton U.S. Courthouse. Presenters will be from both facilities and will include a federal judge. The workshop is free, but reservations are required, and space is limited.

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY AS REGISTRATION HAS CHANGED FROM PREVIOUS YEARS:

- **Minimum age requirement:** Scouts MUST have reached 13th birthday by June 30.
- Registrations will be taken on a first come, first served basis, **beginning at 7:00 A.M. on Monday, April 13.**
- Once the program is full, additional names will be added to a waiting list.
- Registrations will only be taken through the online form. Phone registrations will not be taken.
- You may register multiple Scouts, but you MUST complete a new form for each Scout. Spots will not be held for any Scouts with missing information.
- Collect the following information for EACH Scout before attempting to complete the form(s). Scouts will not be considered registered if information is missing.
 - Parent Name
 - Parent Email Address
 - Parent Phone Number
 - Scout Name
 - Troop # and District
 - Age Scout will be on June 30
 - Allergies/special needs/other health concerns
 - Name of parent attending (optional)
 - Name and cell # of an emergency contact who is NOT attending the program
